



LJCC FUSION -Terms and Conditions

1. Acceptance on a FUSION event is conditional on the completion of application and medical forms.
2. We reserve the right to cancel events that recruit insufficient number of participants.
3. Fees are non-refundable except when FUSION cancels an event.
4. We do not take responsibility for loss and damage to personal effects & valuables.
5. Young people are not allowed to leave the premises of Ivy House without supervision during the sessions.
6. In signing FUSION application forms, I give full permission for the LJCC, in loco parentis, to give any medical treatment deemed necessary by our in house first aiders.

In signing application forms, there is acceptance that your child will abide by the following rules of the London Jewish Cultural Centre.

1. Behaviour or disruptiveness seen by the LJCC as unacceptable or anti social will not be tolerated.
2. Abusive behaviour toward a leader or any other young person will not be tolerated.
3. Damage of property - any value due as a result of damaged property will be charged to the perpetrator.
4. Non - prescribed drugs or alcohol are prohibited at the Ivy House site.
5. Video and photographs may be taken and used by LJCC solely for promotional purposes, in literature and on the website.
6. Where an event is run by FUSION in partnership with or on behalf of another organisation, FUSION will require leaders or representatives of that organisation to be present throughout the event.

If your child acts outside of these rules, they may be excluded from the remainder of the event and you may be asked to collect them.
